Art Frable has twenty-nine years of experience in senior healthcare administration in rural acute care hospitals and the physician clinic environment.

Since becoming CEO in 2010, he has overseen the completion of a \$25 million replacement hospital, reduced expenses by \$1.1 million through renegotiated contracts and added \$2 million to hospital cash reserves.
