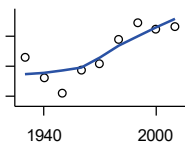

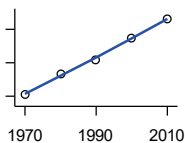

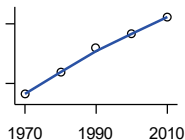
**POPULATION AGE 18 AND OVER

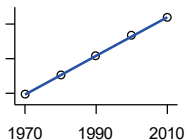
**POPULATION AGE 65 AND OVER

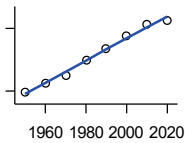

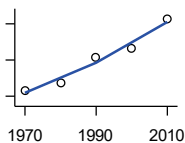

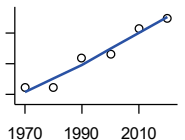

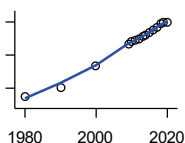

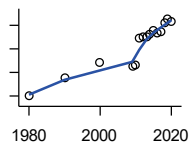

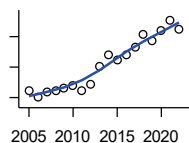

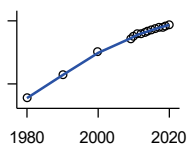

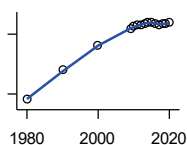

**PERCENT HS GRADUATE OR HIGHER AGE 25+**

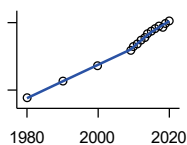

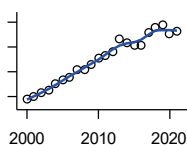

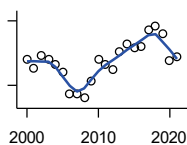

**CHILD CARE FACILITIES: TOTAL CHILD CARE FACILITIES**

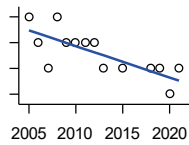

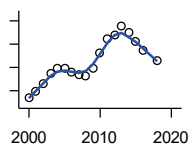

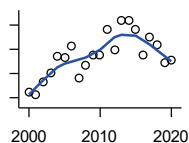

**EST. NUMBER OF RELATED CHILDREN AGE 5 TO 17 IN FAMILIES IN POVERTY**

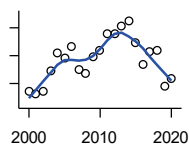

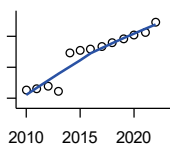

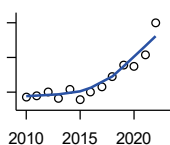

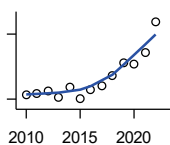

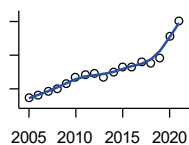

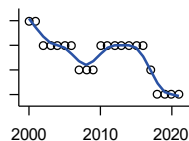

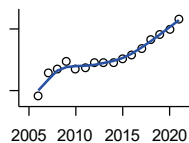

**TANGIBLE ASSESSED VALUATION (KDoR, million\$; 2006-)**



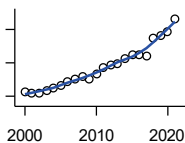

**SALES TAX COLLECTIONS (\$)**

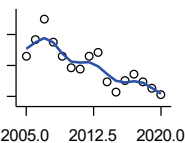

**CRIME INDEX OFFENSES**



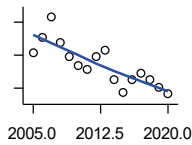

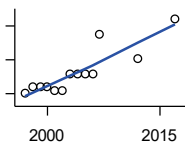
