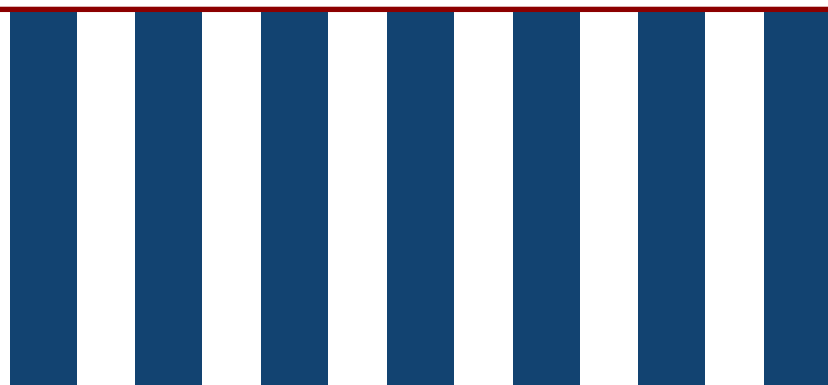


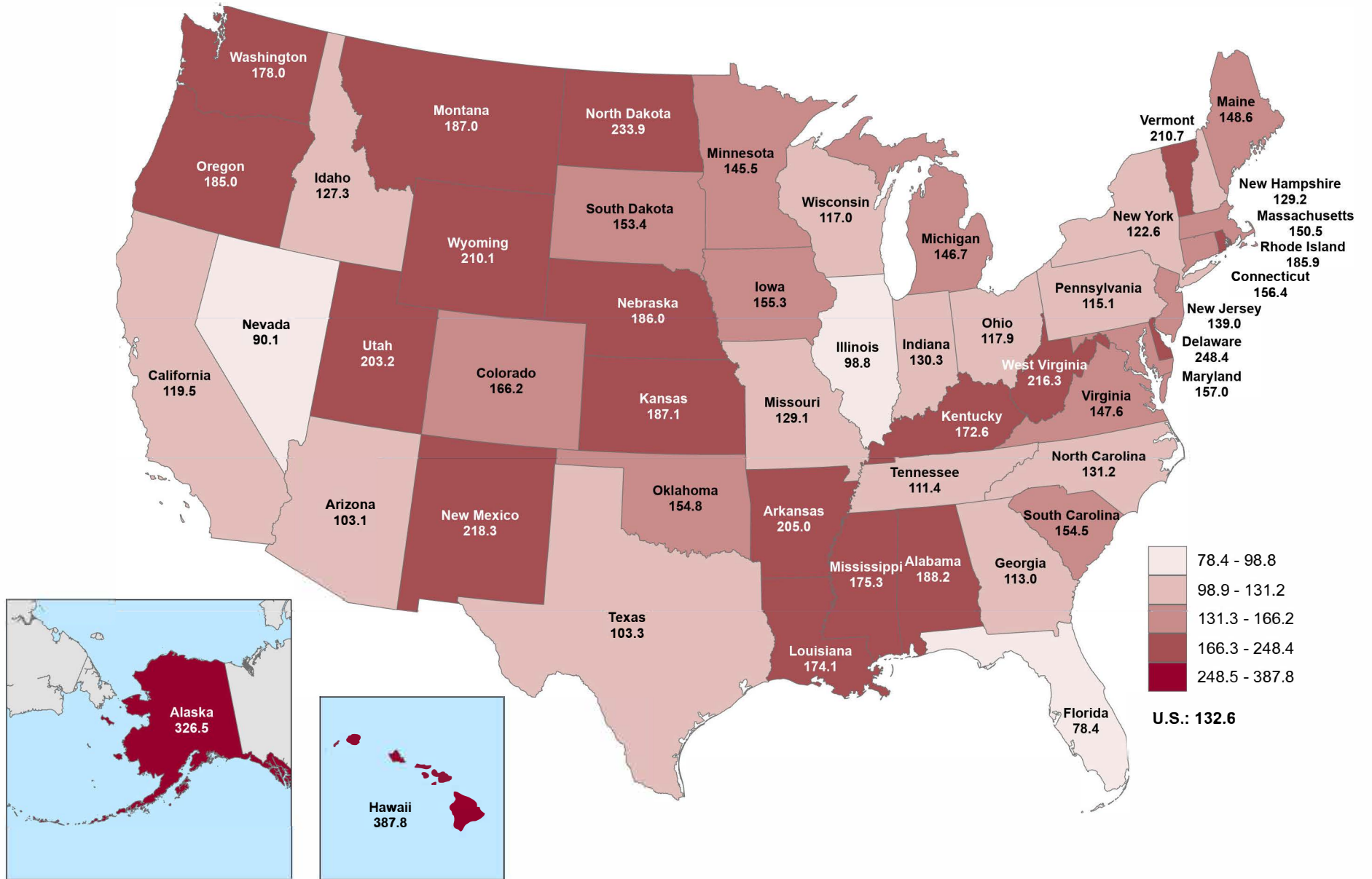

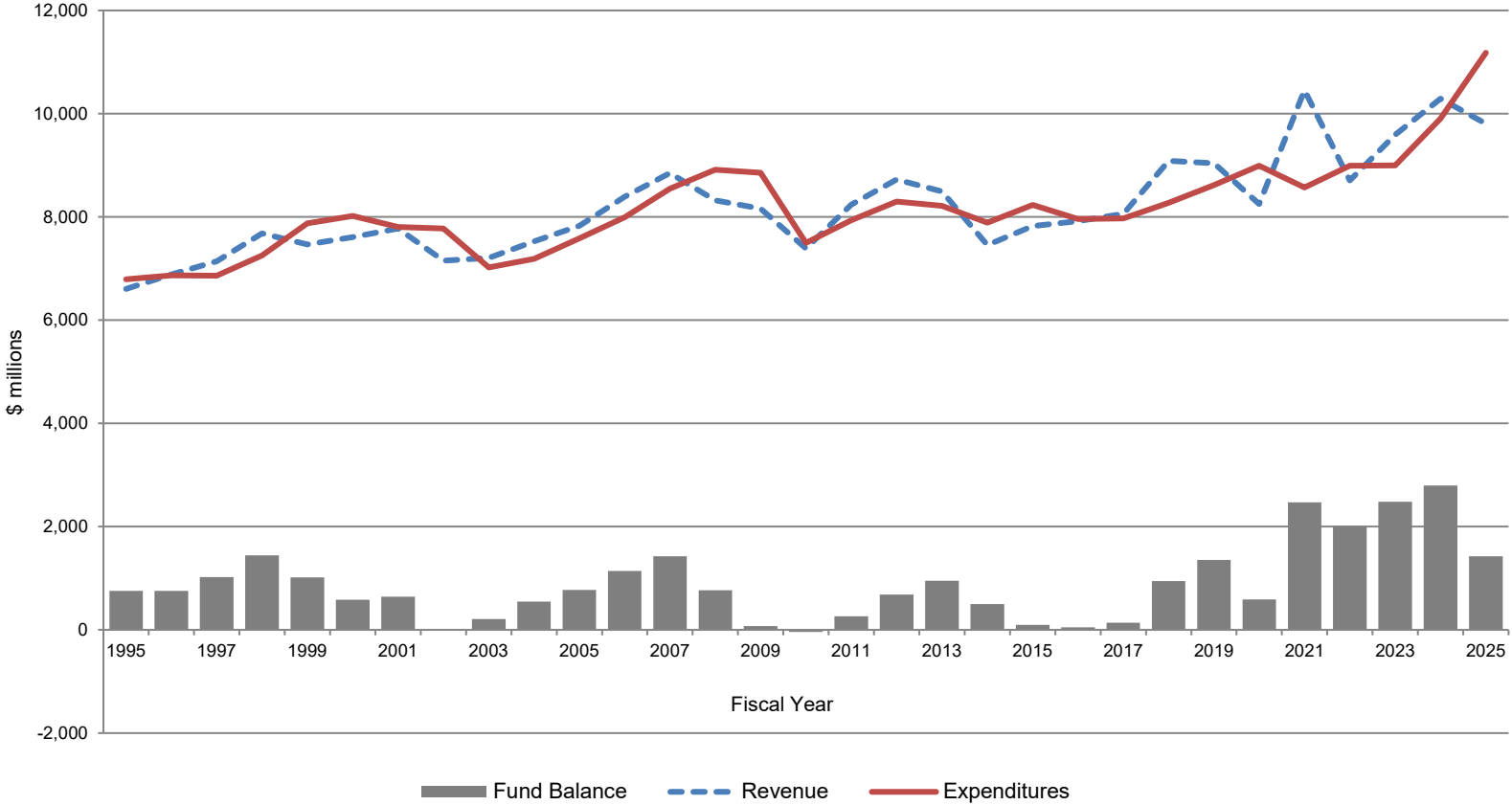

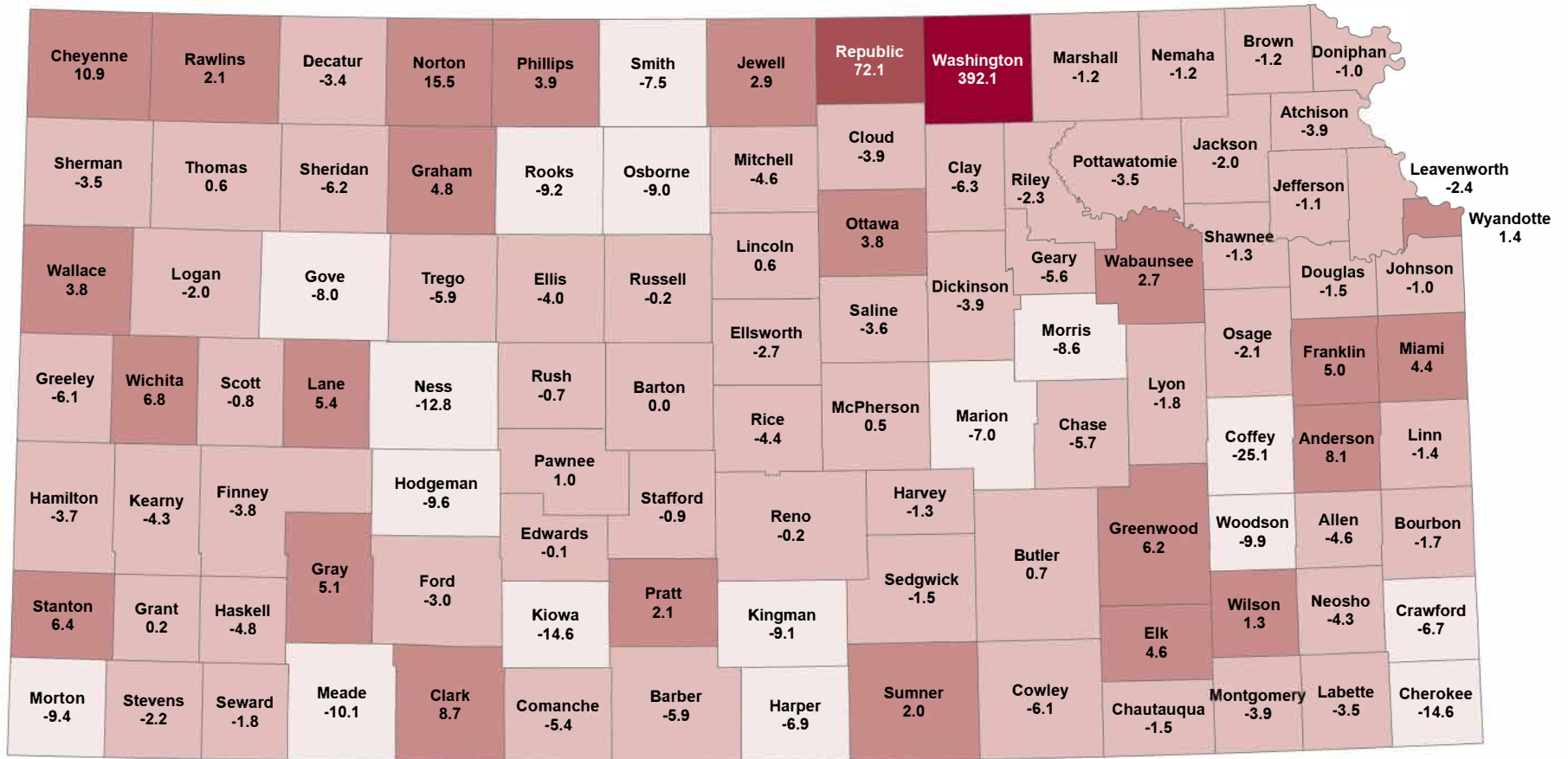

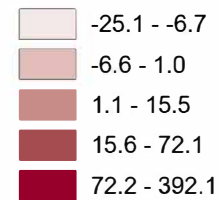

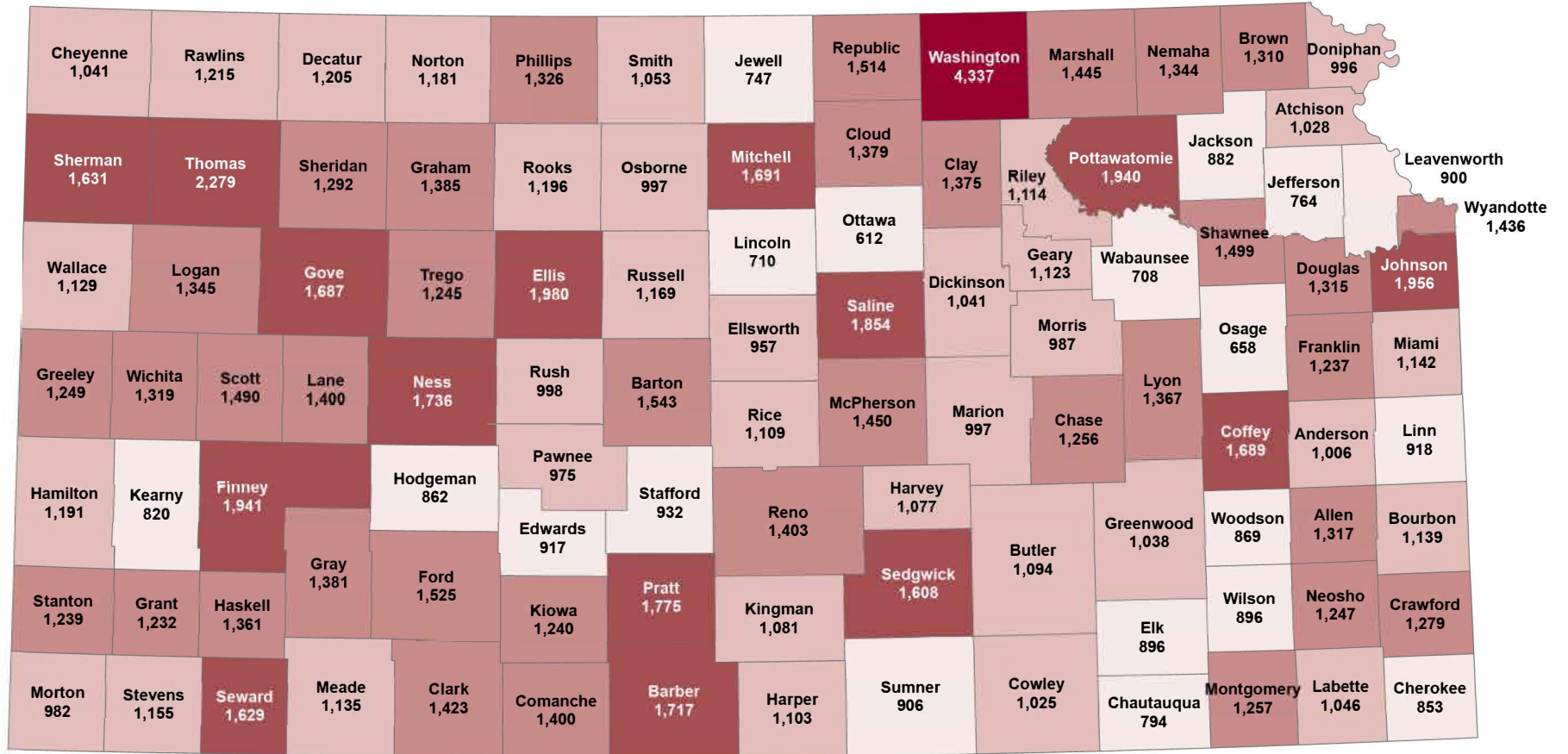

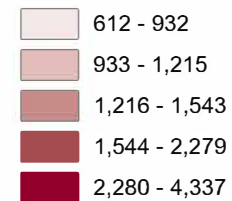
Per Capita State Sales and Use Tax Collections in Kansas, by County Fiscal Year 2023

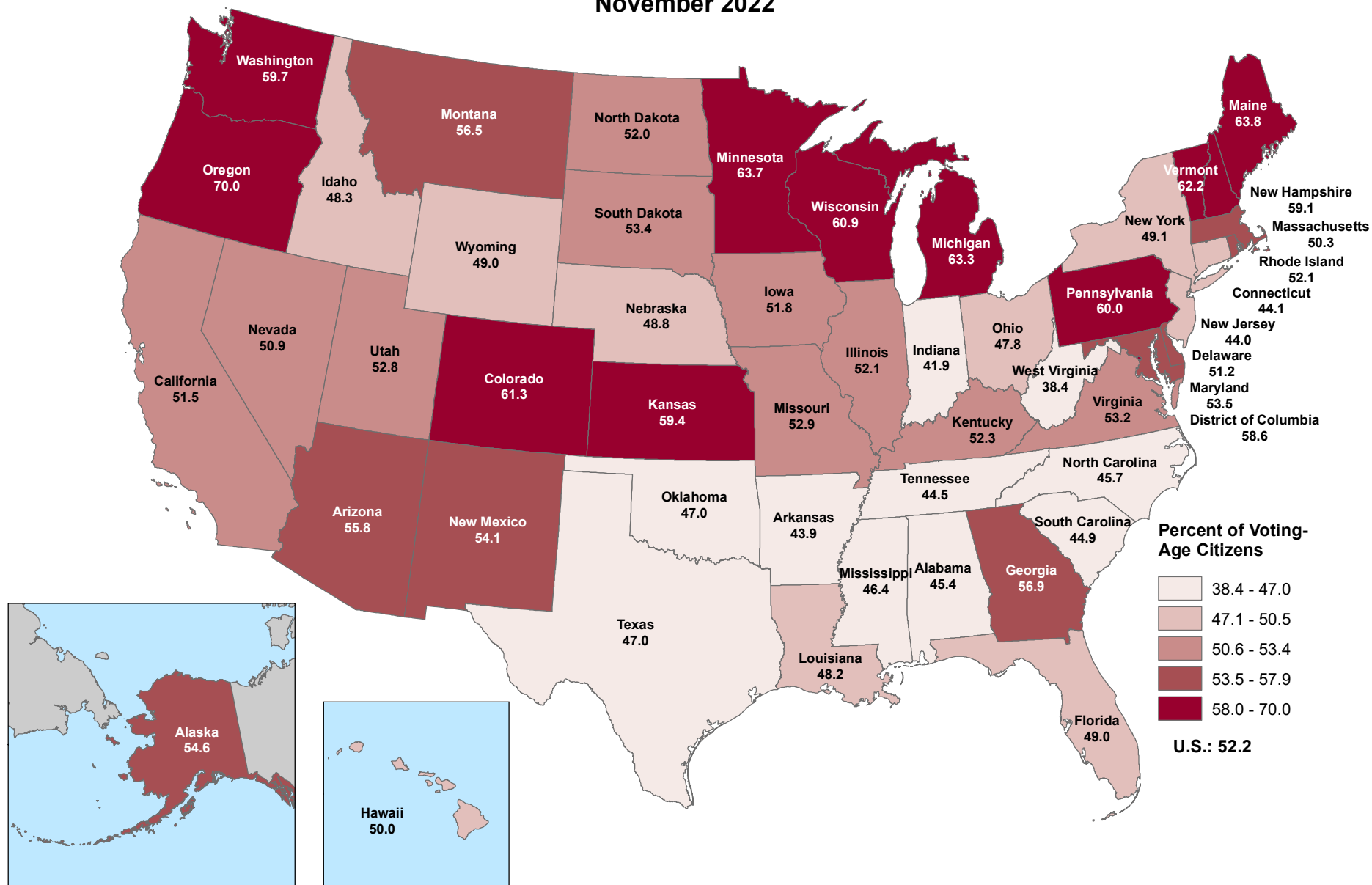
