State failures in response to violence against women have led many Central American women to immigrate and seek asylum. While police generally fail to meet the needs of women, under what conditions will states begin making improvements? Dr. Walsh investigates how transnational advocacy networks have impacted the emergence women-focused policing in some parts of Central America. Her research has been awarded competitive funding from several sources, including the National Endowment for the Humanities, American Council of Learned Societies, and Fulbright-Hays.
