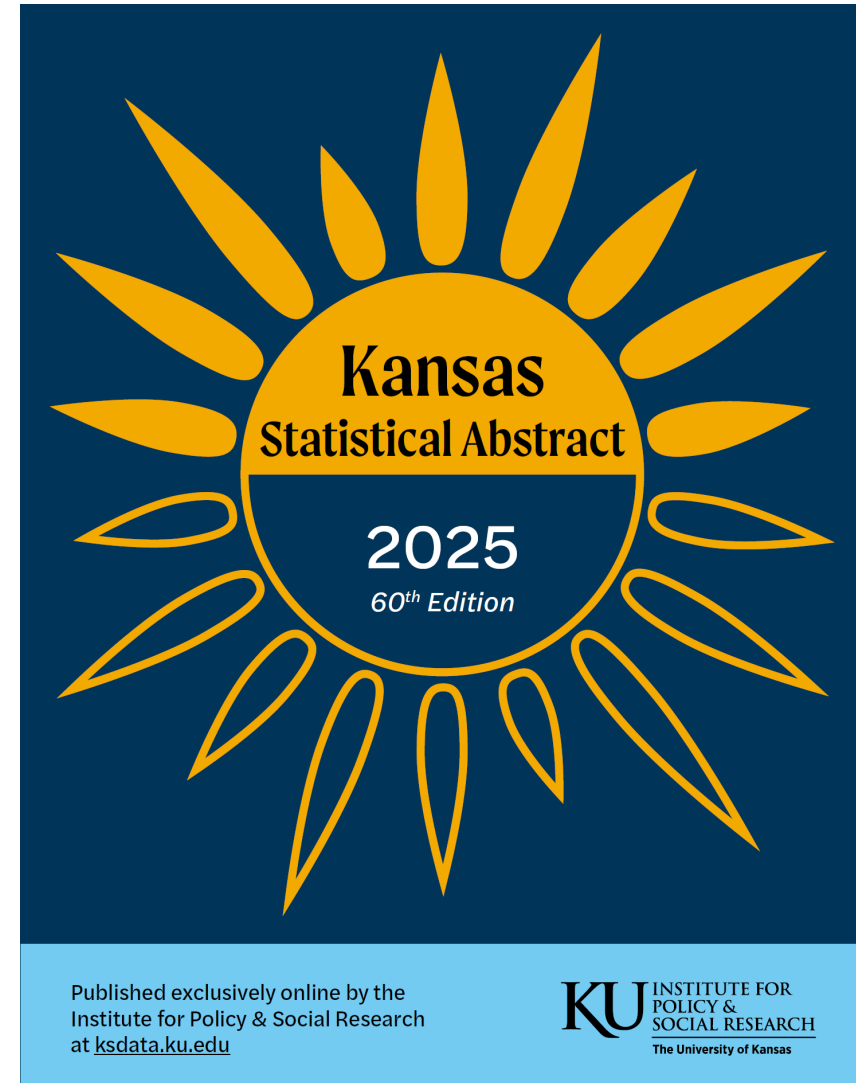

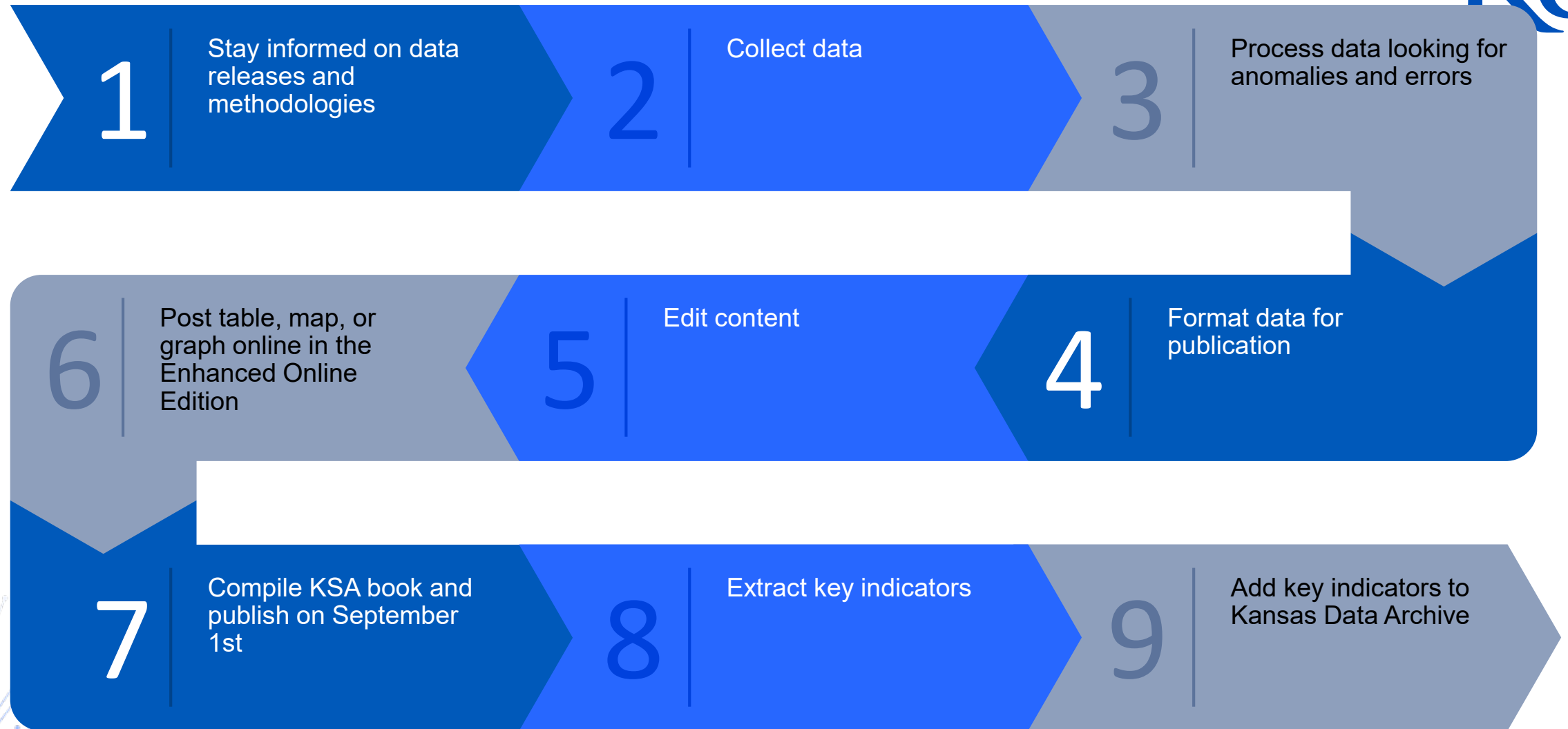

Each table, map, or graph is listed in the bookmarks allowing a user to quickly browse content.

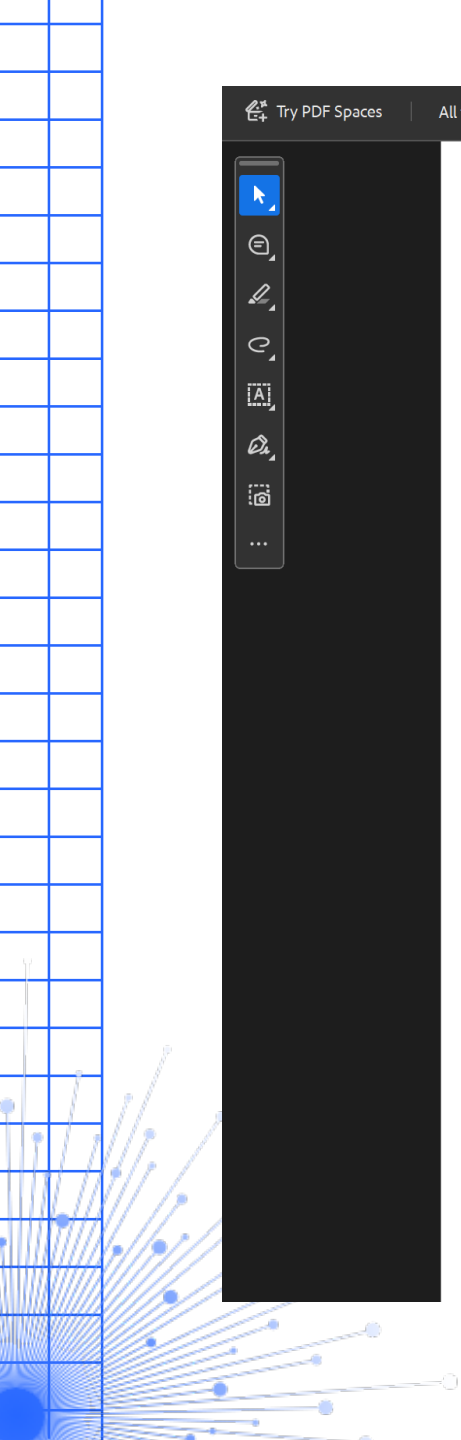
As a single file, the KSA can be downloaded and saved to a local computer for repeated access without the need for an internet connection.

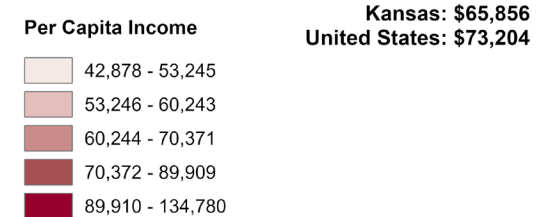

TRUCK REGISTRATIONS, 2024



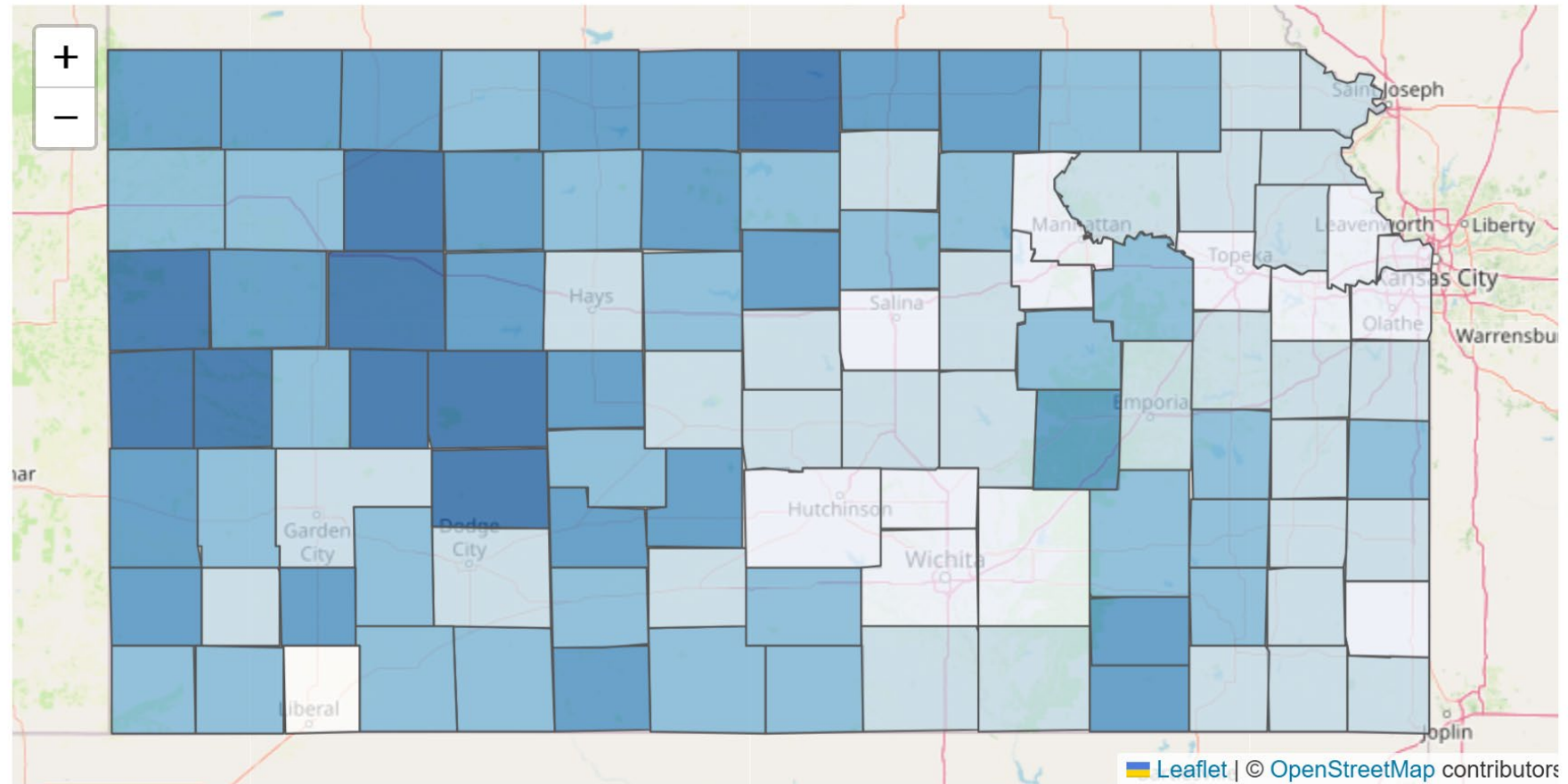

TRUCK REGISTRATIONS (2024) PER CAPITA (2024)



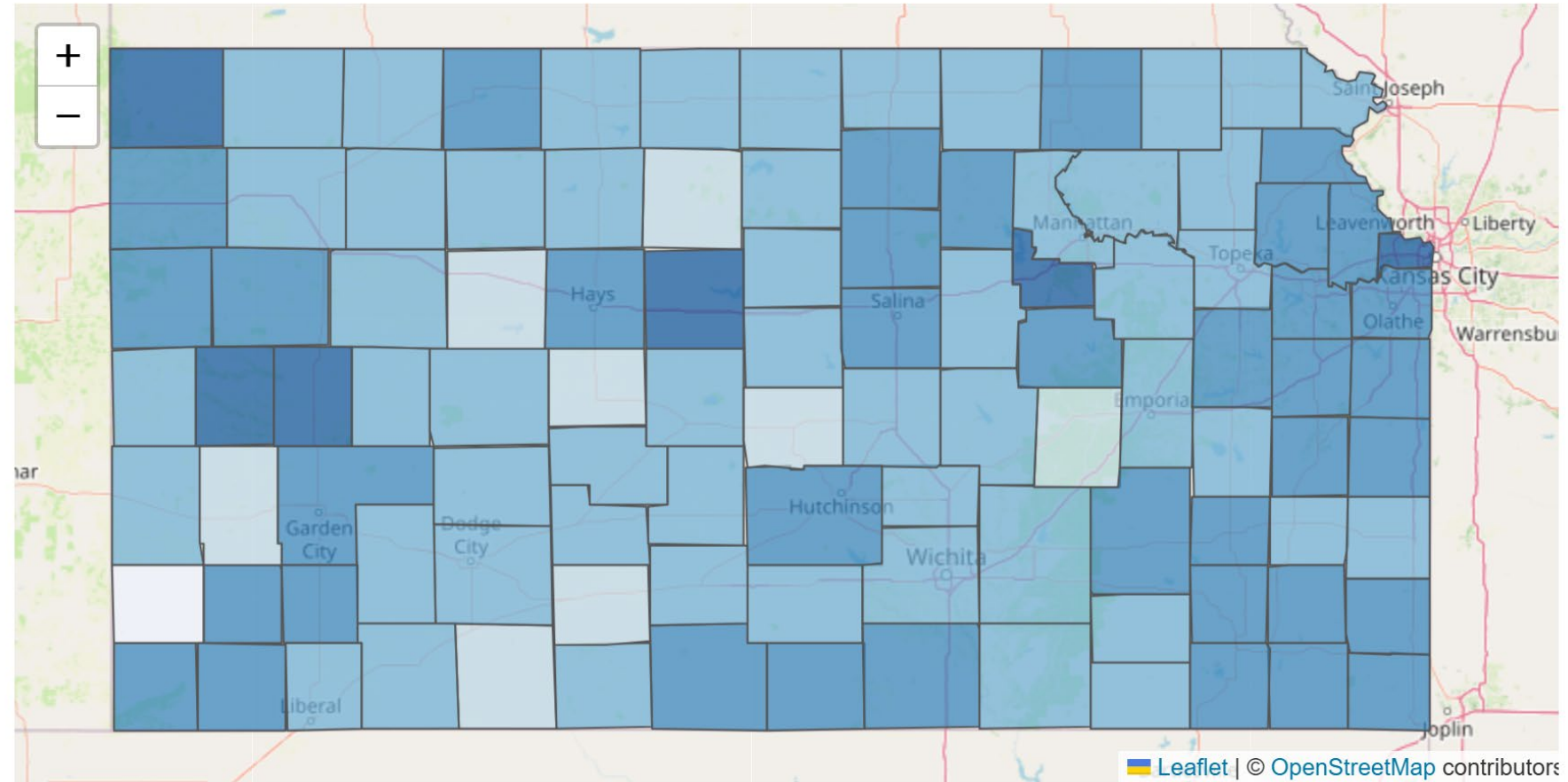

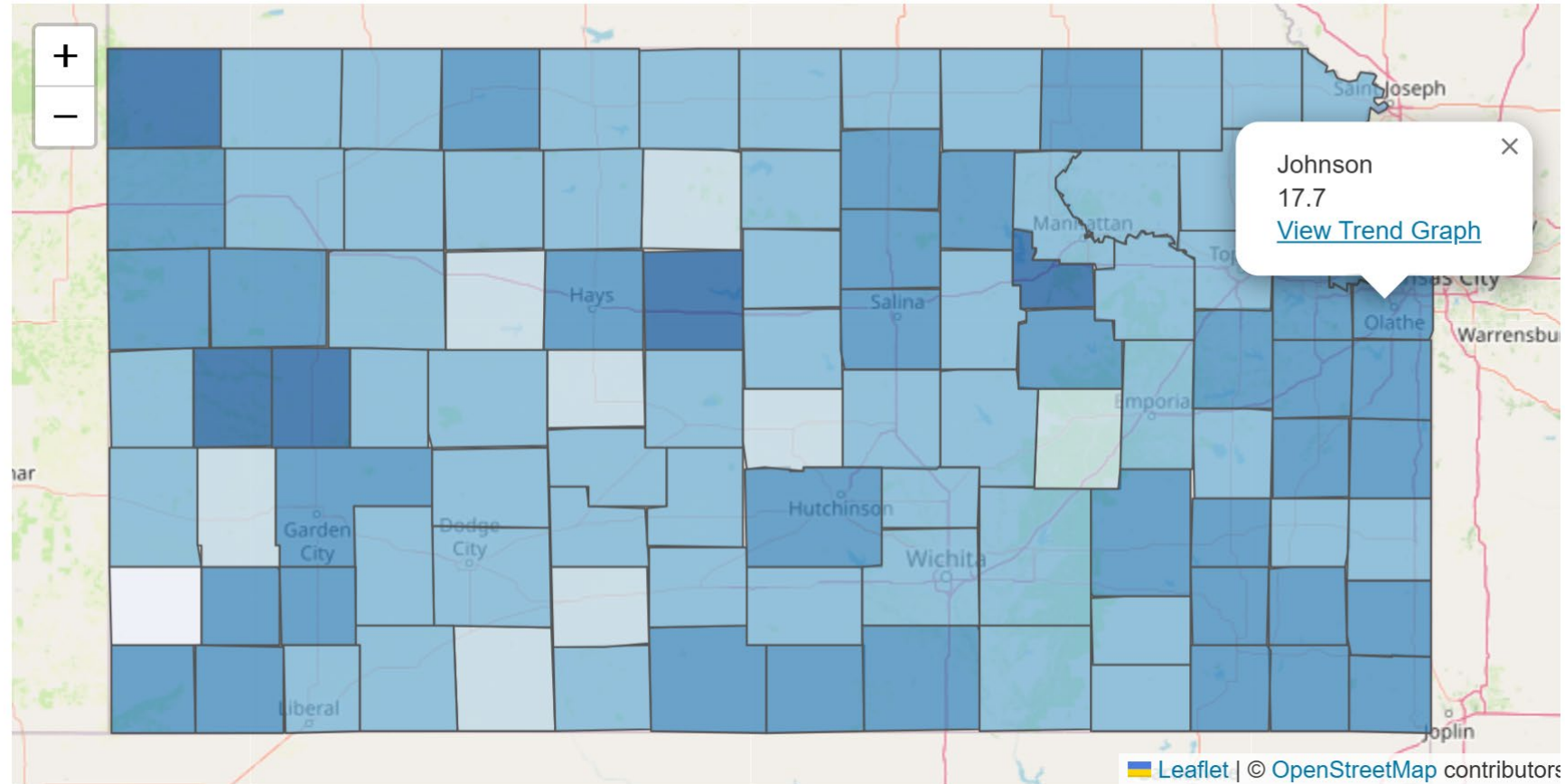

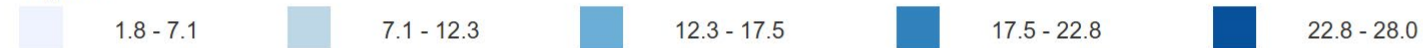

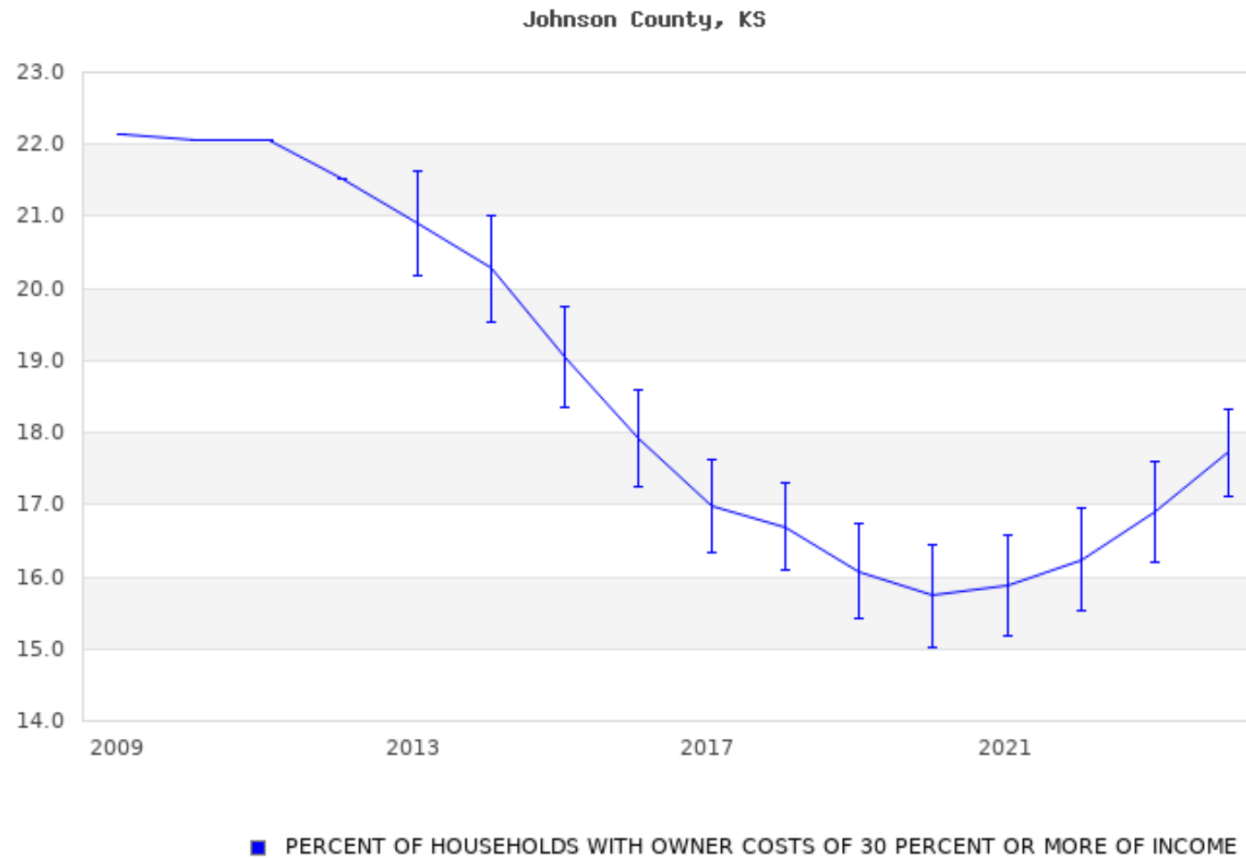
