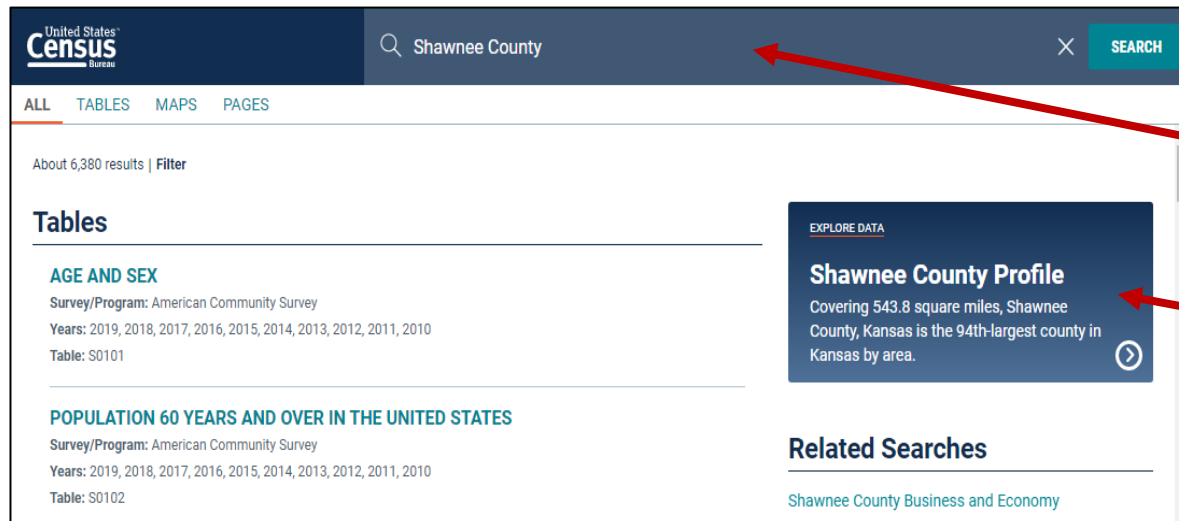

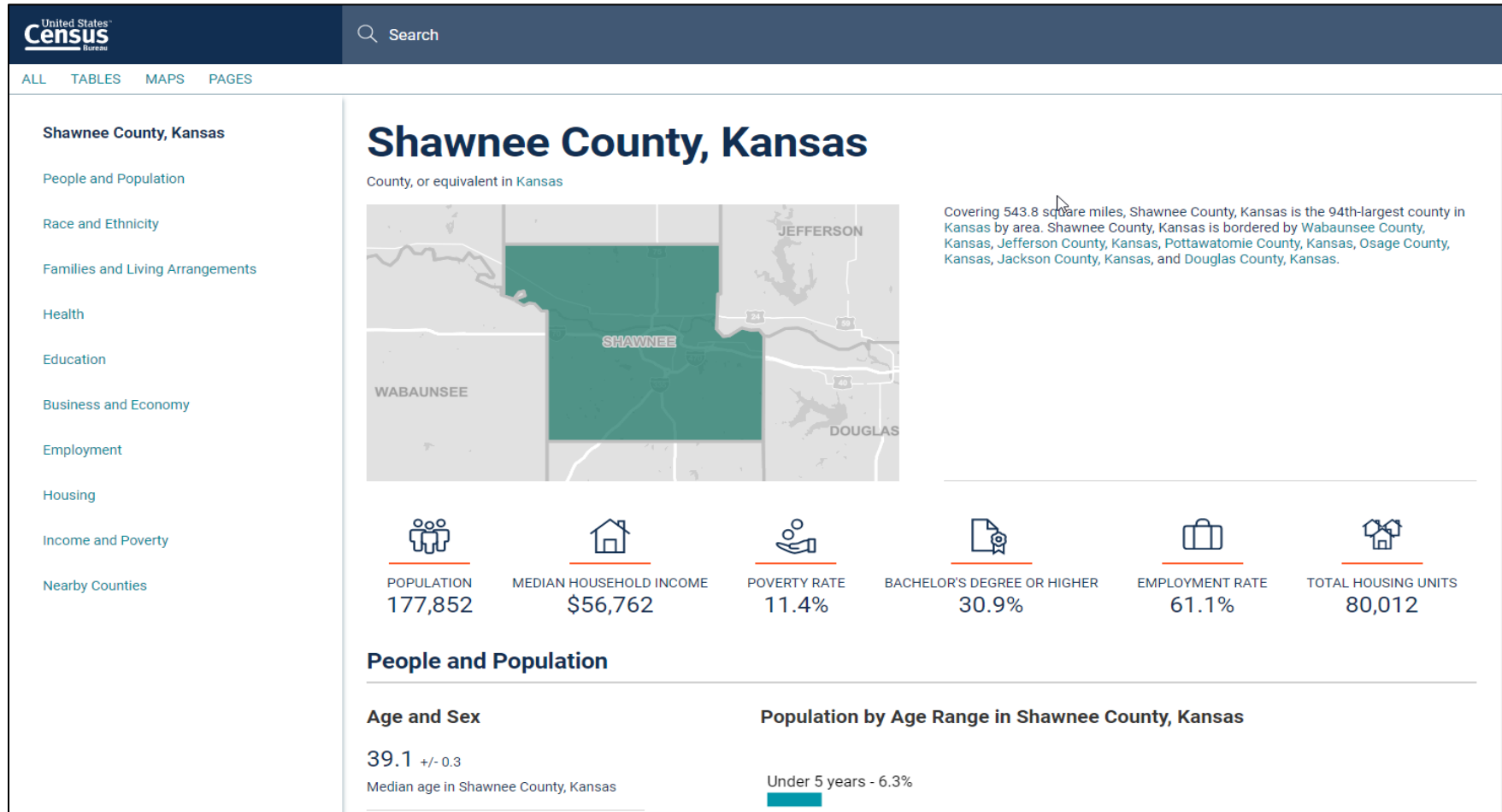

View Your Results

- The percent of occupied units paying between \$500 and \$999 in gross rent was 56.9% in 2019 not statistically different from 2015. This is already adjusted for inflation.
- Median rent in 2019 was \$1,046 not statistically different from 2015. This, too, is already adjusted for inflation.
